Minnesota Living with Heart Failure Questionnaire

The United States Food & Drug Administration (FDA) has approved the Minnesota Living with Heart Failure Questionnaire (MLHFQ) as a Medical Device Development Tool (MDDT) for use in controlled clinical trials designed to test superiority or non-inferiority of medical devices in support of regulatory submissions.

Translation

The University of Minnesota only provides the English language version of the Questionnaire (MLHFQ).

The MLHFQ license allows you to translate the Questionnaire without any further obligations to the University of Minnesota as long as all translations are used for the same study or protocol.

A license for MLHFQ can be obtained through the [MLHFQ website](#). License fee, if due, is paid by credit card. At the end of the licensing process you will be able to download the English language version of the Questionnaire and the license.

We recommend you work with the [MAPI Research Trust](#) (MAPI) to obtain translations of the Questionnaire. Their translations have been validated. There is a nominal fee for the translations. The list of languages the Questionnaire has been translated into is at the bottom of this [webpage](#).

MAPI will ask for a copy of your MLHFQ license agreement to confirm you have a valid license to the English language version before they provide a translation.
